Community: The school is 30 miles south of Atlanta in Henry County. It is one of three specialty high school programs serving all students of all ten high schools of Henry County. The county is one of the largest growing counties in the United States being in the top ten for the past seven years. Currently, the county can be characterized as rural with a county population estimate of 125,000. According to the 2019 United States Census Bureau, the city of McDonough has 25,000 residents.
