<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Ask and answer questions about unknown words in a text.</p> <p>Name the author and illustrator of a text and explain their roles.</p> <p>Describe the relationship between illustrations and the story.</p> <p>Demonstrate understanding of organization and basic features of print, spoken words, syllables, and sounds.</p> <p>Use phonics to read with accuracy and fluency.</p> <p>Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to supply some information about a topic.</p> <p>Use frequently occurring prepositions (e.g., to, from, in, out).</p> <p>Capitalize the first word in a sentence and the pronoun I.</p> <p>Spell simple words, using phonics.</p> <p>Communicate and work with others about what they read and write.</p>	<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Sort objects based on what they have in common, count the number of objects in each group, and order them by amount.</p> <p>Solve addition and subtraction word problems within 5</p>	<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Identify and describe earth materials—soil, rocks, water, and air.</p> <p>Describe how rocks can be grouped by characteristics.</p> <p>Observe and record characteristics of soil such as texture and color.</p> <p>Identify the differences between living and nonliving objects.</p> <p>Show how a set of living and nonliving objects are sorted into groups based on their characteristics.</p>	<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Identify New Year's Eve, MLK Day, and Presidents Day as national holidays & describe why they are celebrated as a national holiday.</p> <p>Identify the national (United States) and state (Georgia) flag as an American symbol.</p> <p>Identify the Pledge of Allegiance, Star Spangled Banner (national anthem), bald eagle, Statue of Liberty, Lincoln Memorial, Washington Monument, and the White House as American symbols.</p> <p>Identify the current president and their association with the White House.</p> <p>Identify the association of Abraham Lincoln, George Washington, and the White House with Presidents Day.</p> <p>Identify an image of Abraham Lincoln, George Washington, and the White House.</p>
