

Luella Middle School Suspension of On-Campus Learning

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why is on-campus learning being suspended at Luella Middle School?
 What criteria were used?

After careful review and consideration of the recent school health metrics and in consultation with local health officials, the decision was made to temporarily suspend on-campus learning for Luella Middle School through Friday, September 17 due to a consistent increase in the number of individuals at the school required to quarantine and/or associated staffing constraints. An anticipated return to on-campus learning is slated for Monday, September 20.

- How long will the suspension of on-campus learning remain in effect?

 The suspension for Luella Middle School runs through the end of the week, September 17.
- How will I participate in classes during the on-campus learning suspension?

 Current on-campus learners at Luella Middle School will temporarily revert back to remote learning operations that were used during the previous school year. Students and families should check with their teacher regarding instruction and assignments for the week.
- How will I be able to receive my school meals?

 Daily curbside meal service will be available through the remainder of the week. Meals can be picked up in the bus lane from 11am-12pm each day. Please let your teacher and/or the front office know by 9am each day if you will be utilizing the school's meal service this week.
