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What Is Title I?

Hampton Middle School is identified as a Title I school as part of every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to challenging State academic standards in order to reinforce and enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Hampton Middle School (HMS) will provide opportunities to improve parent engagement to support student learning. HMS values the contributions and involvement of our families in order to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the many ways that HMS will support parent engagement and how parents/guardians can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and home.

How is it revised?

Hampton Middle School invited all parents to attend our Parent Input Meetings to review and revise this Parent and Family Engagement Plan, as well as our Schoolwide Plan, our School-Parent Compact and the Title I Budget (including the parent and family engagement budget). We also invited all parents share ideas on topics to build staff capacity for parent and family engagement. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and post feedback throughout the year. We also distribute an annual survey by sending it home with students and posting it online to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for parent and family engagement. All unsatisfactory comments from parents will be submitted to the Principal and action will be taken through the appropriate chain of command.

Who is it for?

All students of HMS participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Hampton Middle School will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

We will distribute the plan to all parents in September during the scheduled Annual Title I event. The plan will also be posted on the school website and social media. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the Parent and Family Resource Center.
