
• Authentic Learning "Expeditions"

Mt. Carmel began implementing Project-Based Learning (PBL) in small pockets throughout the 2014-2015 school year. This allows student learning through real-world projects, problem solving, and service learning, both inside and outside the classroom. Students present evidence of their learning to authentic audiences consisting of parents, business leaders and community members. During the summer of 2015, the entire staff received training from the Project-Based Learning Coaches to collaboratively plan PBL units.
