The College Board Opportunity Scholarships lay out six simple steps that all students can take to plan, prepare, and pay for college. For each step in the program that a student completes, they'll earn a chance at a \$500 scholarship. When a student completes all six, they'll earn a chance at \$40,000 for their college education. Half of all scholarships are reserved for students with an annual family income below \$60,000. A total of **308 students in Georgia earned \$329,500** in scholarships in the class of 2020 and 2021.
