## **Commas in Introductory Elements**

Use a comma to set off a mild exclamation, such as <u>well</u>, <u>oh</u>, or, <u>why</u>, at the beginning of a sentence. Other introductory words such as <u>yes</u> and <u>no</u> are also set off with commas.
