## Simple & Compound Sentences

- <u>Simple Sentence</u> – a sentence that has just one independent clause.

Example 1: Curiosity killed the cat.

Example 2: Lee has been eating pies.

\*Independent Clause - a clause that can stand alone as a sentence.

- <u>Compound Sentence</u> — a sentence that has at least two independent clauses. Example 1: I always wanted to be somebody, but I should have been more specific.

Example 2: Lee has been eating pies, and he has been eating cakes.
