2022 – 23 School Improvement Goals

Student Performance Goal #1:

By the end of May 2023, increase the percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient on Georgia Milestones from 27.3% to 30.3% in English Language Arts.

By the end of May 2023, decrease the percentage of students in grades 1-2 scoring low average from 19% to average or above 22% in English Language Arts on MAP.

Student Performance Goal #2:

By the end of May 2023, increase the percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient on Georgia Milestones from 28.3% to 31.3% in math.

By the end of May 2023, decrease the percentage of students in grades 1-2 scoring low average from 24.5% to average or above 27.5% in Math on MAP.

Student Performance Goal #3:

By the end of May 2023, increase the percent of 5th grade students scoring proficient on the Georgia Milestones from 18% to 21% in Science.
