The purpose of the Local School Council is intended to bring communities and schools closer together in a spirit of cooperation to solve difficult education problems, improve academic achievement, provide support for teachers and principals, and bring parents into the school-based decision making process.

Membership includes four parents/guardians of students enrolled in Ola High School, two of whom shall be business persons, so that parents make up the majority of the council. There shall be two certificated teachers who are employed at the school, and the principal is automatically appointed to the council by virtue of his position as designated leader of the school.

The term of office for all elected members to the council is two years and annual training if provided and required of new members.

Meetings for the 2019-2020 school year are scheduled for September 11, October 9, November 6, January 15, February 12, March 11, April 15, and May 13 at Ola High School from 11:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. in the school's Media Center.
