We will:

- Partner with early childhood programs, middle schools, parents resource centers, or other programs (as appropriate) to help prepare parents for a successful school transition.

- Provide trainings for staff during their planning periods on strategies to improve communication with parents and ideas to increase family engagement. Staff will also share best practices during regularly scheduled faculty meetings.
- Share information in English and Spanish, and additional languages as requested, on the school website and in the school newsletter for parents to understand the school's academic standards and assessments as well as the ways parents can monitor their child's progress and work with educators.
- Communicate with all families and the community on a regular basis regarding school wide events and activities, through phone messages, social media, emails, and flyers.
- Work with our parents to develop relevant trainings and helpful presentations to educate our staff on the importance of parental involvement.
- Provide necessary materials and handouts for families at parent conferences, meetings, and activities to help parents work with their child to improve their child's achievement.
- Use our Partners in Education to improve awareness of the activities and events listed in the school Parent and Family Engagement Plan.
- Collect feedback from parents at all events, place input card around the building and post suggestion form on the school website in order to respond to parents request for additional support for parental involvement activities.

WLE SCHOOL COUNCIL-

Wesley Lakes Elementary invites all parents to attend monthly School Council meetings to share ideas and ways to involve other parents to build partnerships with school, families, and the community.

WLE'S COMMITTMENT TO STUDENTS & FAMILIES-

WLE's School-Wide Goals:

- WLE will increase the percentage of 1st grade students reading on or above grade level from 42% to 45%.
- WLE will increase the percentage of 3rd grade students reading on or above grade level from 44% to 47%.
- WLE will increase the percentage of 5th grade students scoring proficient or distinguished in mathematics on the 2025 Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment from 18% to 21%.

1st Semester Progress Indicator:

The percentage of students in grades first thru fifth meeting or exceeding their expected MAP RIT will increase by 4% as measured on the August and December MAP assessment.

School-Parent Compact:

As part of this plan, WLE families develop a School-Parent Compact for student success in learning. This compact is an agreement that parents, teachers, and students develop together that explains how they will partner to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. The compact is reviewed and updated throughout the school year based on feedback collected during forums, surveys, and workshops.
