Grading standards for Personnel Inspection and Physical Training

<u>Personnel Inspection (PI)</u> - Uniform regulations, cadet grooming standards, uniform components, and manner of wear are contained in the NJROTC Cadet Field Manual.

- Cadets will wear the uniform at least <u>one full school day each week</u> and on such other occasions, as prescribed. (Wednesdays are designated NJROTC uniform days)
- Grading criteria for a uniform discrepancy is 5 to 15 points deducted. Cadets are graded on 13 categories for uniform wear including general knowledge questions, proper grooming standards, and military bearing.
- -Failure to maintain uniform standards for the entire school day, without authorization from a NJROTC instructor, will result in an adverse grade and or be changed to a zero if numerous infractions occur.

IF YOU ARE WEARING THE NJROTC uniform, YOU MUST MAINTAIN STANDARDS; if changing before or after school, change out of uniform completely.

-If you have an excused absence the day of inspection (normally Wednesday), it is the Cadets responsibility to wear your uniform the first day of return to school, (even if days later), or the grade will be ZERO.

Physical Training (PT) - Cadets will participate in PT weekly (normally Friday).

- -On PT days Cadets <u>are required to dress in the issued Navy Uniform and participate in all activities.</u> Cadets that opt not to participate, will receive a ZERO.
- Cadets understand that it is their responsibility to bring their Navy PT uniform to school and change during their applicable NJROTC period. Instructors will not supply cadets with Navy PT uniforms if a cadet forgets.
- If a Cadet does not dress out in their issued Navy PT uniform, their grade will be a ZERO.
- Cadets do not have the option to miss PT without written documentation from a parent, doctor, coach, or other authorized person). This notice must include when the cadet can safely resume physical activity.
- ONLY a Doctors medical excuse, will exempt Cadets from missing consecutive PT days. If you have concerns about your scholars' ability to participate in physical activity, please contact the teacher directly.
- UGHS has partnered with GEM Primary Healthcare to provide physicals at a discounted cost. Information will be sent via email. We strongly encourage you to have a physical completed as it is required if a cadet wants to participate in any voluntary team activity within NJROTC.
