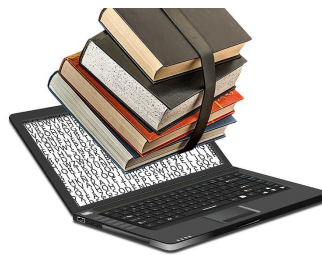

BEHAVIOR CONCERNS

1) Charged Chromebooks

We are having increasing issues with students coming to school without their Chromebooks charged and ready for class.

Most classrooms were provided with 2 chargers but those are starting to fail or disappear.

Even though some students are bringing their own chargers to school we have very limited outlets.

If a student's Chromebook is not charged for class, they will receive a step if they are not able to complete their assignment for the day.

2) Playing Games/ Off Task

We are having an increasing number of students playing games or searching online during class. We have sent numerous screen shots from Go Guardian to parents this week. Students have been warned and warned.
