Math

Ms. Jump's and Mrs. Christian's class:

HCS Formative 6 is located in illuminate. This quiz was due 10/1. All corrections to the quiz must be completed by its close date. It will close 10/17 at midnight and will not be reopened. The students were given class time Friday 10/1 to work on the quiz.

HCS Formative 7 is located in illuminate. All corrections to the quiz must be completed by its close date. It will close 10/17 at midnight and will not be reopened. We completed the first 2 questions in class together Wednesday 10/6 as our warm-up.

1st and 2nd were given class time Friday 10/8 to work on the quiz. 3rd and 4th will be given class time Monday 10/11 and 5th will be given class time Wednesday 10/12 to work on the quiz.

HCS Formative 8 is located in illuminate. This quiz will be due by Friday 10/15. All corrections to the quiz must be completed by its close date. It will close 10/24 at midnight and will not be reopened.

1st and 2nd were given class time Friday 10/8 to work on the quiz. 3rd and 4th will be given class time Monday 10/11 and 5th will be given class time Wednesday 10/12 to work on the quiz.

Social Studies

We completed our European History & Government unit last Friday. This week we began our European Economy unit, and we will end it this Friday, October 15. There will be a unit test. Just a reminder that all missing classwork can be turned in for full credit. All classwork assignments can be found in Google Classroom.

Science

We will begin studying why we have seasons and the role that the Sun, Moon, and Earth play in the changes of weather. Our next test will be in two weeks. A study guide will be sent home this week to begin study.

English

Ms. Justice's and Ms. McBride's class:

This week, we will continue working on our Informational unit. We will be reading an informational text in class. Students will be answering comprehension questions and answering a constructed response question using the RACE strategy. We have put grades in for the performance task. Students who have not completed this assignment should have noticed a big decline in their grade. Students will have until this Friday to complete this assignment. The performance task assignment is a narrative essay.

- ** Please encourage your child to finish any incomplete assignments at home. Also encourage them to ask questions if they do not understand something. All assignments will be posted in google classroom. Students are encouraged to use the google slides if they did not understand something in class or if they are absent.
- ** Please encourage your child to read at least 15 minutes a day. This is such an important skill and will be so beneficial for your student.

Reading Support/System 44/Read 180 (Edwards)

- **Headphones**-Students **MUST** bring earbuds/headphones to class everyday.
- **Student App**-Students **MUST** complete 20 minutes of their System 44 or Read 180 app in class daily. Students must complete a minimum of 60 minutes per week for a practice work grade. Any minutes over the 60 minutes will be counted as extra credit.
- Independent Reading-We have begun to work on our independent reading station. System 44 students can select books related to their topic in the app or by Lexile. For every book they read they must complete a reading log, and then take a quiz on that book. They must pass with a 70 or above. If they make below 70, they will be allowed to retake the quiz. Read 180 students will also be expected to read a book or e-read based on their Lexile score, complete a QuickWrite, and then take a quiz. These quiz grades will be recorded in Infinite Campus.
- Missing Work-Due by Friday, October 8th. Please continue to remind students to check Infinite Campus for missing work.
- Class Procedures-Please remind students to use the hand signals required in class. Holding up 1 finger means that a student needs to speak to a neighbor, 2 fingers for students mean that they need to get out of their seat to somewhere inside the room, 3 fingers means that students need to sharpen their pencil, 4 fingers means that a student needs to ask the teacher a question. When the teacher raises up 2 fingers and says "2", this means that the teacher is asking for silence. When the students need to use the restroom, they will use the sign for "R". These signals are posted in the classroom above the board.
