The Georgia Department of Education applied for a waiver seek ing relief from the federal No Child Left Behind Act. As a result, the United States Department of Education agreed to use a new system, the College & Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI), to report the progress of Georgia' s public schools. In January 2 0 1 3 the Georgia Department of Education released the final list of indicators on which schools will receive a CCRPI score.

#### CONTINUOUS SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

**Goal 1:** Austin Road Middle School will increase the percentage of students in grade 8 reading on or above grade level from 60% to 65% as measured by the 2024 Spring MAP Assessment.

**Goal 2:** Austin Road Middle School will increase the percentage of students in Algebra 1 scoring proficient and above on the 2024 Georgia Milestones Assessment from 45.83% (based on 2022 – 2023) to 50%.

Georgia is a member of the WIDA Consortium. All members of the WIDA Consortium utilize the same screeners to assess eligibility for language assistance services.

Henry County uses the WIDA-ACCESS Placement Test (W-APT).
