









Annotating a PDF with The Google Classroom App on a Chromebook

<p>On your Chromebook, click the circle in the bottom left of the screen.</p>	
<p>This opens your installed apps. Find the Classroom app from the list. If you don't see it, you can type Classroom in the search bar.</p>	
<p>Open the Google Classroom that contains your assignment</p> <p>Click the Classwork tab.</p> <p>Find and click the assignment you need to complete.</p> <p>Click on the up arrow at the bottom of the screen to reveal the attachments.</p>	
<p>Click on the PDF icon in the attachments section to open your copy.</p>	

<p>Click on the pencil in the top right corner of the screen to begin writing on the document.</p>	
<p>Choose the type of pen or highlighter you want to use to draw/write on the document.</p>	
<p>You can change the color and size of the drawings tools as well.</p>	
<p>When you are at a stopping point or finished with the document, click the save button.</p>	
<p>Now you are ready to Turn In your assignment with your annotations.</p>
