Curricular Communication

Dear families,

Let us take this opportunity once more to welcome each and everyone to Second Grade. For the next four to six weeks we will be focusing on the following concepts.

**Math** - In math we will continue our unit on Understanding Place Value of three digit numbers. In this unit we will focus on developing an understanding of place value with three digit numbers. We will focus on grouping tens as hundreds, writing numbers in standard form, word form, expanded form and base ten form. As well as representing numbers as hundreds, tens and ones. We will also be focusing on identifying the value and place value of digits in numbers.

**Language Arts** - We will begin our unit in Determining the meanings of words and phrases in a text relevant to the subject area. With the Theme "Look Around and Explore", we will continue to ask/answer questions to better understand the passages, find the Central Idea of the story and also identify the Author's Purpose to help comprehend the story.

**Writing** - We will begin our writing unit with informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement.

**Social Studies** - We will continue our Social Studies unit learning about the history and geography of Georgia. In this unit, students will learn the significance of the location of cities in Georgia in relation to rivers, landforms, and resources in each region. Students will also learn the similarities and differences of each of the five regions in Georgia.

**Science** - We will continue our unit on Matter. We will be focusing on describing the Physical Properties of Matter, the forms of matter as well as the effects of heating or cooling matter.

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
