Upcoming Learning

ELA: This month the 4th grade students will read passages in search for answers to this essential question. ***How do your experiences help to shape your identity.*** The 5th grade students will read to learn ***what kind of circumstances push people to create new invention.***

MATH: 4th graders will be learning more about place value to the hundred thousands, comparing and ordering multi-digit numbers and rounding multi-digit whole numbers.

5th graders will be introduced to volume of rectangular prisms, numerical expressions, exponents and powers of 10.

Social Studies: 4th graders will be learning about the American Revolution. 5th graders will be learning about the Turn of the Century.
