- 1) Go see a play with a small note pad and pen to take notes.

- 2) In your first paragraph give a brief summary for the play. Your first or your last sentence of the first paragraph is going to state what your critique is going to focus on.
- 3) Use the follow list of questions help you focus you critique:

- 4) Take a picture of your ticket stub or play program and uploaded it with 2-page paper.
- 5) You are limited to only 2 extra credit papers a semester.
- 6) Turn your 2 lowest grades into the grade of your paper. If your critique grade is lower than your lowest grade than no change in grades.
- 7) Please use spell check, Grammarly, and read your paper out loud before turning it in.

- 9) Paper should be Times New Roman Font size 12 and double spaced.
