PRIORITIZE HOMEWORK

Please priority a time for HOMEWORK! 5th Grade is heavy in content. Prioritizing is important because it ensures that students don't feel overwhelmed with school work. We want our kiddos to make steady progress.

BEANSTACK

5th Grade students must log their nightly reading in Beanstack. The first challenge is due August 29th. Readers should have 500 minutes logged in their accounts. Mrs. French will run the report for us.

HOMEWORK

- 1. Pass three Read Theory quizzes daily. Ask your 5th grader to show you their quizzes in their account. It will show you're their reading level and their grades.
- 2. Complete Daily Language Review. Resources are in Google Classroom. They can also use their Google Search.
- Finish any incomplete work from our school day.
- 4. Read 30 minutes and log it in Beanstack. Ask your 5th grader to show you their Beanstack account. Look to see if they have logged at least 30 minutes for the day.
- 5. Practice Multiplication Facts using flashcards or links in Google Classroom. The goal is to solve 80 facts in 2 minutes.
- 6. Study Science and/or Social Studies. Resources are in Google Classroom and in their binder.
- 7. Charge Chromebook daily.
