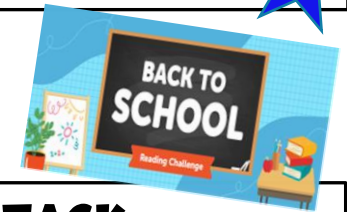
HOMEWORK
