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**Course Name and Code:** Team Sports / Lifetime Sports

**Supplementary Texts or Special Materials:** PE clothing and athletic shoes

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**Course Description:** Students will learn rules and history of and participate in playing team sports.

**Course Outline and Content:** Students will participate in competitive games of basketball, volleyball, badminton, table tennis, softball, soccer, ultimate frisbee, tennis, and pickleball.

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**Classroom Rules and Discipline Procedures:** All students must adhere to the rules and expectations outlined in the Henry County Schools student handbook and the Union Grove High School student handbook addendum.

1. Be in the gym when the bell rings.
2. Dress out and participate daily-Weekly dress out and participation grade is as follows:  
Dress out-10 points per day-50 points per week  
Participation-10 per day-50 points per week  
Weekly total of Dress out/Participation-100 points per week
3. You are still expected to participate even when not dressed out to earn participation points.
4. A note from a parent is required to excuse a student due to injury or illness. It will be accepted for a *maximum of three consecutive days*. A *doctor's note* is required for anything *more than 3 days*.
5. You must wear athletic shoes to receive dress out points. PE clothing must adhere to the school dress code.
6. Do not share lockers. Make sure your locker is locked at all times. UGHS is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
7. **No electronic devices (see cell phone and electronic device policy).**

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8. FOOD, DRINKS, GUM ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE GYM OR THE LOCKER ROOMS!!

9. **NO TOLERANCE** for damage to PE equipment, gym or classroom. No tolerance for fighting or abusive language. Any student who kicks a ball in the gym will automatically be written up for behavior detrimental. Any student who kicks or hits a ball into the ceiling will automatically be written up for behavior detrimental and may owe the cost of the ball.

**Hall Pass Policy:** Restroom passes will not be given the first 10 minutes or the last 10 minutes of class. Restrooms are open during each class change and are to be used during that time. The student will be dismissed from class only if he/she becomes ill or if circumstances arise which prevent the student from using the restroom between classes or if medical documentation is provided. Student passes will be allocated using our student conductor system. The student conductor system will allow students to log where/when they are leaving the class. Once a pass is approved by student conductor, the student will receive a written pass from the teacher. Students will be limited to one restroom pass per hour. *If student conductor does not allow a student to get a pass, no paper pass will be issued.* Students are not allowed to take their cell phones with them into the restroom.

**Chromebook Policy:** It is an expectation for students to have their charged Chromebook with them every day. Failure to do so will be regarded as “not being prepared for class.” **No personal laptops will be allowed.**

**Make-up Policy:** Students must see the teacher to make-up any missed assignments during excused absences. **This is YOUR responsibility. Your instructor will not seek you out to get your work completed.**

**Grading System:**

40%: Practice Work (performance skills check-offs, ¼ tests, web-based assignments, participation, dress-out etc.)

40%: Assessment Tasks (classwork, notes, quizzes, written test and/or written/project based exam)

20%: Final Exam

**Cell Phone/Electronic Device Policy:** The cell phone/electronic device policy begins when students enter the designated classroom area. All students will place all cell phones/devices in the teacher assigned caddy. During this time, cell phones must be turned off. Additionally, all smart watches or other electronic devices connected to the phone must be caddied until the end of class. Cell phones/devices will remain caddied until the end of class. Students will NOT be allowed to take their phones/devices out of the room when they have a hall pass to the

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restroom, media center, etc. Students will be allowed to use cell phones/devices before first period, during lunch, and during class transition.

***On Time Policy:*** In order to be considered “on time” to class, the student must be across the threshold of the classroom or designated classroom area by the end of the tardy bell.

***Locker Room Policy:*** We strongly encourage students to use a locker in Physical Education. Students need to purchase a combination lock. Once the student picks out the locker, they must provide the teacher with a locker number and lock combination. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

***Exam Exemption:*** To encourage and reward excellent attendance, each student may earn the right to exempt one (1) spring semester non-state required final exam. Each student must meet clear guidelines to qualify for this exemption. Please see our school website for all requirements and guidelines.
