Increasing Literacy Skills

- As a School: We will provide extra focus on real-world application through vocabulary and make additional resources available in our Resource Room for parents to use at home to help our students.
- As a Parent: I will visit the Parent Resource Room to check out resources to ensure I can support my scholar at home with real-world application to increase vocabulary and discuss their progress.
- As a Student: I will participate by using the real-world application through vocabulary, resources, and be ready every day to learn in the classroom and at home by asking for additional help in subjects as needed.
