



HAMPTON MIDDLE SCHOOL'S DRESS CODE POLICY

Dress for Success!

The expectations outlined below are a portion of the entire dress code. Please see the 2023-2024 Henry County Schools Student and Parent Handbook to read the Dress Code policy.

- Tank tops or spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- Shorts, skirts, culottes, split skirts, or dresses must be reasonable in length all the way around and appropriate for school.
- Clothing that is too revealing or form-fitting may NOT be worn.
- Headpieces/headgear, including but not limited to hats, visors, hoods, grooming aids, headbands, head scarves, and sunglasses, will not be worn within the school building unless approved for special occasions by the principal.
- Bandanas or any other clothing, jewelry, or item symbolizing gang affiliation WILL NOT be worn/displayed at any time on campus.
- Holes in pants above the knee and below the pocket may not expose bare skin or underwear.
- Leggings/spandex pants (yoga pants) may not be worn unless the buttocks are covered with a shirt or jacket that reaches mid-thigh.
- Biker shorts or bicycling-type outfits are prohibited and will not be allowed.
- See-through clothing, bare shoulders, bare midriffs (or back), halters, and tank tops are prohibited.
- Blankets, slippers, or pajamas are unacceptable and should not be worn in the building.
- No undergarments should be visible at any time; pants should be worn at the waist.
- Low or plunging necklines are not allowed.
- Inappropriate writing or pictures, including but not limited to, clothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco, drugs, any prohibited product, sex, depicts or suggests violence, or which contains suggestive writings, pictures, or emblems that are inflammatory, vulgar, or discriminatory, MAY NOT be worn.
- Slides are not allowed. Crocs will need to be worn in sports mode for the duration of the school day.
- **Any other items deemed inappropriate by the principal could be added to this list. Please see the Henry County Student Handbook for additional information regarding the student dress code.**
