

DUAL ENROLLMENT



Overview

The Dual Enrollment (DE) Program provides for participation in Dual Credit Enrollment for Eligible High School and Home Study students. These students earn postsecondary credit hours while simultaneously meeting their high school graduation or Home Study completion requirements. GaFutures.org

Eligibility

Effective Summer term FY2021, eligible high school students, enrolled in 11th and 12th grades, may receive Dual Enrollment funding for eligible core courses in English, Math, Science, Social Sciences and World (foreign) Languages, or Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE) career pathway courses at eligible participating postsecondary institutions, up to the 30 semester or 45 quarter hours program Funding Cap.

End of 10th Grade- Approved CTAE courses.
