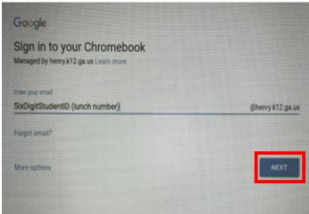
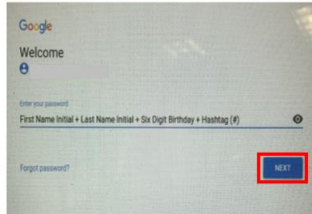


## Chromebook: Sign in to your Chromebook

<p><b>INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK</b></p> <p><b>DO's</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Insert name slip in clear pocket on case.</li><li>• Tie a luggage tag that includes your name around the case's handle.</li><li>• Zip the case during transit.</li></ul>  <p>Always-On Protective Case</p>	<p><b>INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK</b></p> <p><b>DON'T's</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Remove the device from protective the case.</li><li>• Remove the bar code.</li><li>• Place stickers on the case.</li><li>• Write on the case.</li></ul>  <p>Always-On Carry Case</p>
<p><b>INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK</b></p> <p><b>DO's</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use to fully charge device at home.</li><li>• Leave power cord at home each day.</li><li>• Attach a removable name label.</li></ul>  <p>Power Cord / Charger</p>	<p><b>INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK</b></p> <p><b>DON'T's</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bring power cord to school each day.</li><li>• Permanently label the power cord with your name.</li></ul>  <p>Power Cord / Charger</p>
<p><b>INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK</b></p> <p><b>DO's</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bring to school fully charged.</li><li>• Safely store when not in use.</li><li>• Dust keyboard for crumbs and debris.</li><li>• Lock the laptop whenever you leave your machine unattended.</li></ul>  <p>HP Chromebook 11G5EE</p>	<p><b>INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK</b></p> <p><b>DON'T's</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Remove from the protective case.</li><li>• Place stickers or labels anywhere on the device.</li><li>• Eat or drink near your machine.</li><li>• Close the laptop with any foreign objects on the keyboard, i.e. pencil or pen.</li></ul>  <p>HP Chromebook 11G5EE</p>
