

# Southern Crescent Technical College Driver's Education

**Authorized Provider - Joshua's Law Course**

*Learning to drive is a major milestone in a teen's life. It is important for young or inexperienced drivers to learn safe driving techniques. There are four (4) different ways Joshua's Law can be satisfied for teenagers to meet their requirements for a Class D License. The course that is offered by Southern Crescent Technical college meets the option that includes 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of drive time which include closed course driving with an experienced instructor.*

**Most insurance companies also give a reduction (approx. 10%) on insurance premiums upon successful completion.**

**Note:** Participants must be at least 15 years of age and possess a Learner's Permit. Participants must attend all classroom dates for the full class period and also must complete all six (6) hours of behind-the-wheel driving.

## **Course Cost: \$350**

\*\*\*To receive the scholarship for Driver's Education, the student must be a Georgia resident between the ages of 15-17 with a Learner's Permit. Please see our website for other qualifications.
