

The **SECURING OF OUR CAMPUSES** ensures that instruction and learning can take place at the highest levels for our staff and students. Recent security enhancements include:

- * A 1:1 ratio of School Resource Officers to all secondary schools (27 total)
- * Addition of single-point entries and security doors at all high schools to mirror those at our elementary and middle schools
- * Visitor sign-in process & ID badge system at all schools
- * Piloting a campus response system for lockdowns

SECURING OUR CAMPUSES

A **POSITIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT** leads to a greater sense of security for all members of a school community. Various resources and support measures ensure that disruptions are minimal, and learning is optimal by:

- * Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) promotes self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making
- * Partnerships with organizations to provide help with mental/physical needs
- * Response team of school counselors, social workers in times of need

SECURING A POSITIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

If an emergency situation does occur, the district is **READY TO RESPOND** in partnership with emergency management agency officials, local law enforcement, and first responders by:

- * Ensuring all emergency response plans are annually approved by the Henry County and Georgia Emergency Management Agencies
- * Utilizing a comprehensive communication plan to allow timely and accurate information to be shared with all community members
- * Establishing routine meetings with emergency officials to ensure preparedness
