Woodland High School Registration Checklist

- > The following documents are required for school enrollment.
- > Once you have gathered all necessary documents, please contact the Counseling Department at 770-389-2784 to schedule an appointment.
- □ Proof of Residency in the attendance zone.
- 1- Valid Lease or Rental agreement with parent as lease holder and signed by both parties AND

 GAS or ELECTRIC bill dated within 60 days with the enrolling parent's name and service address or a letter of utility verification

OR

2- Property Tax Bill or Settlement Statement in parent's name AND GAS or ELECTRIC bill dated within 60 days with the enrolling parent's name and service address or a letter of utility verification

OR

- 3- An affidavit of residency from the Board of Education.
- □ Academic transcript/Discipline record. Prior to admission, transfer students in grade 9-12 must provide a certified copy of their <u>academic transcript and discipline record</u> from prior school or a parent/guardian must authorize release of all records from the previous school.
- □ An official document showing proof of birth date. Examples include an original birth certificate or birth registration or an official state or federal form with date of birth.
- □ Proof of custody/guardianship, if you are not the birth parent. Court ordered Guardianship is required for registration. Please contact Henry County Probate Court at 770-288-7600 to obtain guardianship information.
- □ A Georgia certificate of Immunization. Georgia Form #3231 is available only from licensed Georgia physicians and Health departments. Take your child's immunization records to a Georgia Physician or health department where staff will complete the form. A fee may be charged if additional immunizations are required. Also, there may be a normal charge for transferring information to the state form. Sate-required shots include Hepatitis B, DPT, Polio, HIB, two MMR shots, and Chicken Pox vaccine/proof of illness. A valid Form 3231 must be marked in the appropriate box with either "Complete for School Attendance" or "date of Expiration. By state law, a valid immunization form or immunization exemption (for medical or religious reasons) is required for enrollment. Contact the Henry County Health Department at 770-288-6136 or your physician for more information.
- □ Evidence of vision, hearing and dental exams obtained in the past year. This information must be on Georgia Form #3300, available only from the health department and from most Georgia physicians and dentists. Letters from appropriate healthcare professionals and out-of-state certificates are acceptable, if completed within the previous 12 months and stapled to the state form. These exams are available at Georgia health departments for a fee. There may be a nominal charge for transferring information to the state form.

***Please note it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to gather the necessary paperwork. Registration will not occur until necessary paperwork is gathered. ***
