Units of Study

The high school world history course provides students with a comprehensive, intensive study of major events and themes in world history. Students begin with a study of the earliest civilizations worldwide and continue to examine major developments and themes in all regions of the world.

Expectations

This is a College Prep class taught with a high-level critical thinking. Students are expected to study every night and complete chosen assignments on time. Behavior and work expectations are high and are expected to be maintained by the students. Failure to do so will result in parent and administrative contact.

Course Description

The Georgia and Henry County standards offer our students a more thematic study of the world. Units will cover from early civilizations to modern times, and topics will include underlying themes in human behavior, human-environment interaction, map skills, and information and contextual analysis. This will be accomplished through collaboration, document analysis, projects, and games.

Late Work Policy

Due dates will be created as a class and set on the board and in Google Classroom. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain a calendar of due dates and turn work in on time. After the due date, deductions will be added based on the time frame below.
