- ❖ Student must complete 20 service hours during the school year. These will be signed off by the adult coordinating the event. All SERVICE HOURS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE CLUB PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT PRIOR TO COMPLETION. (See the attached list of approved service activities and suggestions.)
- ❖ Student will turn in 250 soda tabs to be donated to the Ronald McDonald charity. (This will not count as service hours but rather a separate requirement for membership.)
- ❖ Attendance at all Beta Club Meetings. If an absence occurs, the member must present a signed excuse. Accepted excuses are a note from a coach or from a parent (only 1 per semester permitted). If circumstances beyond your control occur, permission from the Beta Club Sponsor and Club President can override this requirement.
