Grade Repair 	Each high school will hold a 2-week grade repair process for qualifying students at the end of spring semester.	Students who earned a final grade of 60-69 during the Spring 2023 semester in an approved course (below) while enrolled in a HCS school.	Seniors: May 4 th – 16 th 9 th -11 th Graders: June 2 nd – 15 th
District Credit Recovery 	Henry County Schools will implement a credit recovery program through digital platforms via Impact Academy.	Students who earned a final grade of 55-69 in an approved course (below) while enrolled in a HCS School.	June 6 th – July 13 th Students can register through June 23 rd .
School-Based Credit Recovery 	Individual schools have the option to hold site-based Credit Recovery options during the summer months, mostly in June.	Students who earned a final grade of 55-69 in an approved course (below) while enrolled in a HCS School.	Dates vary by schools.
Course Repetition 	Students can retake a course through their home school (if offered), Impact Academy, or an approved external fee-based provider*.	Students who previously failed a course and choose to retake the course of the summer, regardless of the final grade during the initial attempt.	Impact Academy: June 6 th – July 13 th Other School or Provider Dates Vary
Initial Course Credit 	Students may take initial credit during the summer via Impact Academy or an approved external fee-based provider*.	Students who are seeking to earn an initial credit(s) during the summer and are taking the course for the first time.	Impact Academy: June 6 th – July 13 th Other School or Provider Dates Vary

*Students MUST go through the advisement process with a school counselor for a course credit to be earned through a Summer Learning option, even from an outside vendor.

	1. Look for communication from your school about their grade repair and credit recovery processes as early as Friday, April 28th. Your school will provide details on how to get advised, enroll, and participate in Summer Learning options.
2. Take time to review your grades from different courses throughout the school year, and check the list from the previous page to see if those courses are offered for summer learning.
