7th Grade Engineering Technology


Students will conclude with Google Sketch-Up and begin learning about the Engineering Design Process along with the concepts of Invention & Innovation.

HEALTH NEWS...


Health students will continue their Abstinence Unit "Choosing The Best" this is a two week unit that required parental consent.
