The **Army National Guard** is the **ONLY** component of the US military whose existence is **REQUIRED** by the **US Constitution**

The National Guard is a unique and essential element of the U.S. military. Originally, the National Guard operated as a citizen force organized to protect families and towns from hostile attacks, today's National Guard Soldiers hold civilian jobs or attend college while maintaining their military training part-time, always ready to defend the American way of life in the event of an emergency.

THE ARMY COMPONENTS

*ARMY NATIONAL GUARD (PART-TIME)

- 1 weekend a month & 2 weeks a year (*39 Days per year*)
- Over 90 unit locations in GA (can't be assigned outside the state unless requested)
- Controlled by the Governor of Georgia
- State & Federal Mission = Receive BOTH State & Federal benefits

*ARMY RESERVES (PART-TIME)

- 1 weekend a month & 2 weeks a year (39 Days a year)
- 12 duty stations in GA (can be assigned outside the state)
- Controlled by the Commander in Chief (President)
- Federal Mission = **ONLY** Federal benefits

*ACTIVE DUTY ARMY (FULL-TIME)

- 365 days a year (*Minimum contract of 4 year Commitment*)
- Over 72 duty stations without the world (*30% are outside the US*)
- Controlled by the Commander in Chief (President)
- Federal Mission = **ONLY** Federal benefits

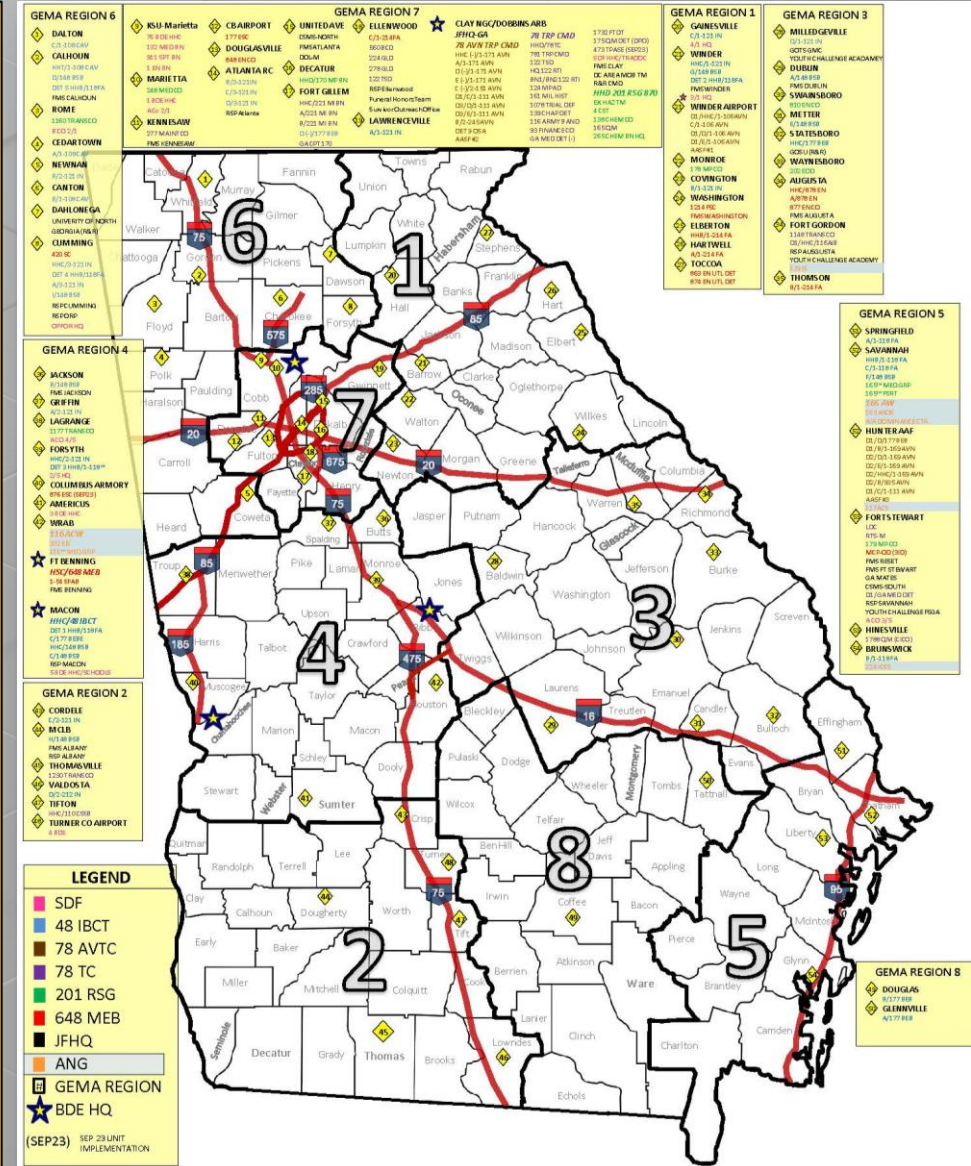

RECRUIT SUSTAINMENT PROGRAM (RSP)

Designed to prepare you for **Success** in Basic Training & AIT

Duration: 2 Days a month prior to shipping to basic training

Locations: 9 Locations throughout the state (soldiers typically drill at the RSP location within their recruiter's area)



BASIC TRAINING:

Duration: 10 weeks

Locations: Ft Benning, GA; Ft Jackson, SC; Ft Leonard Wood, MO; or Ft Sill, OK

ADVANCED INDIVIDUAL TRAINING (AIT):

Job-specific training on the Job **YOU** selected

Duration: 6 weeks to 12 months (*varies on MOS*)

Locations: Various locations throughout the US



Note: Can be accomplished during summer months with minimal disruption to academic schedules.

FEDERAL TUITION ASSITANCE

Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA): \$4000 paid to the school for tuition & fees per year (Up to **\$250** per credit hour for 16 credit hours)

Federal Credentialing Opportunities On-Line (COOL): Pays up to **\$4000** annually for certifications and licenses related to their jobs & civilian careers



G.I. Bill: pays full-time students **\$439** per month for 36 months (**total = \$15,804**)
3/4 time = \$329, 1/2 time = \$219, Less than 1/2 time = \$110

G.I. Bill Kicker: is an additional incentive that pays you an extra **\$350** per month for 36 months if you score over a **50** on the ASVAB (**total = \$12,600**)

Note: The G.I. Bill benefit is paid directly to the Soldier (not the school)

- Be a **U.S. Citizen** or **Permanent Resident**
- Score at least a **31** on the **ASVAB** or **SASVAB**
- **Meet all Medical** and **Physical** requirements
- **Meet Moral** (Law) requirements
