

The bottom graph gives a break down of grade categories in the course. It shows how each type of assignment is weighted. The graph also shows a student's average for their different categories. Example: This student has completed 9 assignments out of the 94 that they complete over the course of the semester. 4 of the assignments were graded. The average of the 4 assignments is a 100%. This 100% is counting for 15% of the students's overall grade.

The second progress bar shows a student's OVERALL grade. This is the average of all of the assignments they have

> A student's ACTUAL grade is their "progress report" grade. If a student is on target or ahead in a course, their OVERALL grade and their ACTUAL grade will MATCH. If they are behind and their top progress bar is red, the ACTUAL grade will be lower. The ACTUAL grade averages in zeros for assignments that should have already been completed. When a student catches up in a course, the zeros are removed.
