"Idle Time" calculates how long a student was logged in to Edgenuity, but not working. Small amounts of idle time can be explained by the time it takes to read passages, take notes, etc. If parents or teachers notice large amounts of idle time, they may need to question a student about their productivity.

The log further breaks down activity by date. On Tuesday, this student worked for 2hrs and 12 minutes and completed 4 activities. You can see a further breakdown of the specific times and subjects a student worked in under each date. As a general rule, students should work consistently in a class for 60-90 minutes per day and/or complete 5-10 activities per class. Students can use the "Assignment Calendar" under their Organizer in Edgenuity to view specifically which assignments they should complete each day to stay on target in a course.
