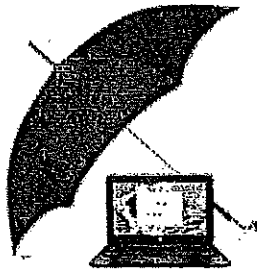

## Annual Technology Protection Coverage



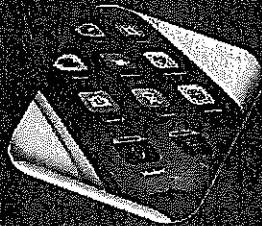
All devices are covered by a limited Accidental Damage Protection plan (ADP) to protect the device against most accidental drops, spills, bumps, and structural failures incurred under normal operating conditions or handling. However, this district-funded plan excludes improper use/mal-intent/intentional damage. In general terms, damage to a device as a result of obvious intentional abuse by a user, a device that has been submerged in liquid (rendering it unrepairable), a crushed device (rendering it unrepairable), or a device otherwise damaged as a result of use outside the district's Acceptable Use Policy would be excluded from ADP coverage. In addition, the ADP does not cover replacement of a lost device and/or accessories. Parents/guardians may be charged for damages to their student's device, not covered by the ADP.

As a service to parents/guardians of 3rd - 12th grade students, an "optional" HCS technology protection plan may be purchased at a nominal cost of \$10 per student and no more than \$70 per household. This fee covers the replacement costs associated with the student's assigned device in the event of catastrophic loss due to fire or acts of nature, theft, and damages not covered by the Always Learning Maintenance

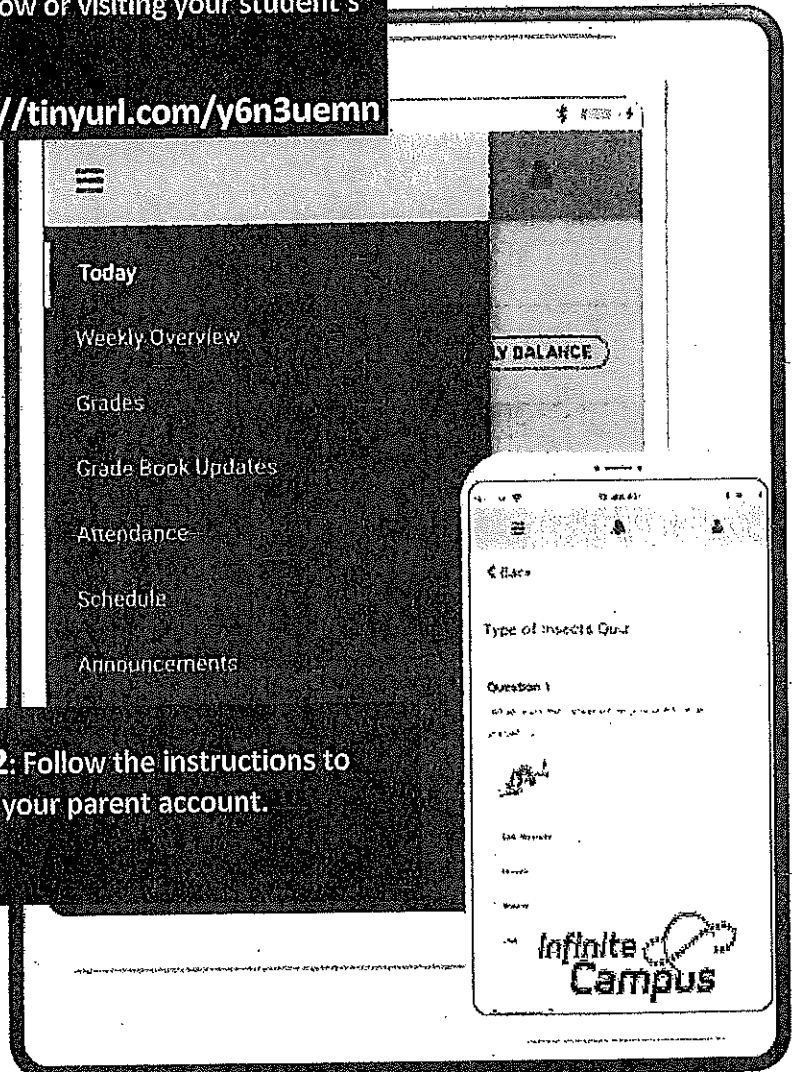

# Immunization Rules for 7<sup>th</sup> grade students...



All children entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade are required to meet the following...

- 1) Have two (1) dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis), & (1) dose of Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine.
- 2) Contact your healthcare provider to receive any vaccinations & to obtain the Georgia certificate of Immunization( form 3231).

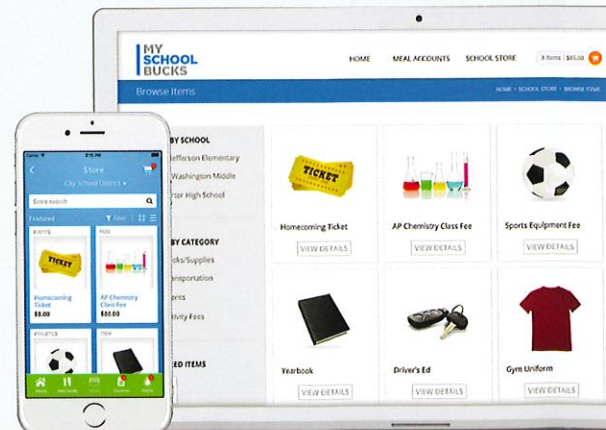

LUELLA LIONS...*HEAR US ROAR!*

Dear Luella Middle School Parents and Guardians,

As the new school year is upon us, we are excited for all that awaits your child inside our classrooms and the rich learning experience they will have to help achieve all they set their minds to.

In recent years, these learning experiences and our teachers' aim to positively impact our students seemed to be in a regular struggle to keep students' attention away from cell phones and the distractions they create. Our school and all other middle schools in the county are attempting to meet this issue with some sensible solutions by implementing guidelines and rules around the use and misuse of cell phones by our students.

Students are not prohibited from bringing their cell phones to school, but they are prohibited from having them out at any point from the first bell to the dismissal bell. Students should place their phones in their locker upon arrival to school and only retrieve them or use them at the conclusion of the school day.

Students found to be in violation of the new cell phone rule can receive the following consequences:

1. Phone taken up for class period
2. Phone taken up for remainder of the day
3. Parent Contacted
4. Office Referral

To further assist with this new requirement this school year, here are a few FAQs to provide greater clarity to several of the question we know will be asked.

#### Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. *Why is this new rule being implemented?***  
We only have so long in the day to provide the greatest education for your child. Competing with a cell phone is not the best use of time, and this is a simple solution for everyone.
- 2. *Are other middle schools following this rule change?***  
Yes. All middle schools are taking this approach to the use of cell phones in schools.
- 3. *What about the use of cell phones for technology in the classroom?***  
With the introduction of the Chromebooks and 1:1 technology for all students in third grade and above, there is no longer a need to have cellular devices. Additionally, the use of these devices can slow down the WiFi network for all students in the school.
- 4. *What if my child has an urgent need and must contact me?***  
There is a phone provided in the front office for any student to use to contact their parents.
- 5. *What happens in the event of an emergency situation where I need to hear from my child?***  
Our first commitment to our students is their safety and overall wellbeing. In the event of an emergency, the use of a cellular device can be a dangerous distraction for students who should be focused on the training they have received and listening to the guidance from the teachers, staff, and administrators. The communication regarding emergency events will be shared in a timely manner with parents by school officials.

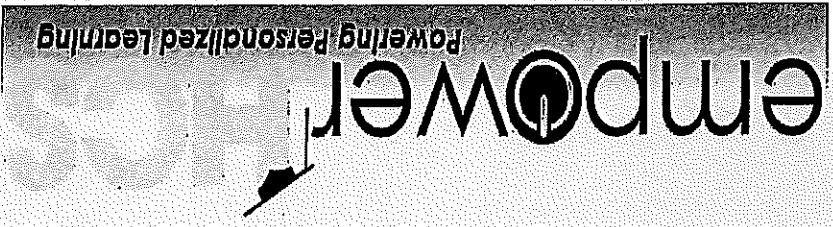
