

## **How can I be successful in Biology?**

### **Before class, I need to:**

1. Find a quiet, distraction-free room at home.
2. Read the section in the textbook/Interactive Reader the night before we talk about it in class.
3. Take some bullet points from your reading the night before we talk about it in class.
4. If there's anything in the reading you don't understand, Google it.

### **During class:**

1. Keep your eyes on the teacher at all times.
2. Repeat what the teacher says in your head.
3. Write down the important points your teacher says/draws.
4. Make yourself ask questions if there is anything the teacher says you don't understand.

### **After class:**

1. Spend 15 minutes at a time, read through your notes each night and memorize them.  
**\*\*Study Tip:** Make flashcards for vocabulary, placing terms on one side and definitions on the opposite side.
2. If needed, go see your biology teacher (or a different one) before or after school for help.

### **How can I study for the tests?**

1. Study in 15 minute chunks every day!
2. Complete your study guide CORRECTLY! Use your book, not the internet!
