How can I be successful in Biology?

Before class, I need to:

- 1. Find a quiet, distraction-free room at home.
- 2. Read the section in the textbook/Interactive Reader the night before we talk about it in class.
- 3. Take some bullet points from your reading the night before we talk about it in class.
- 4. If there's anything in the reading you don't understand, Google it.

During class:

- 1. Keep your eyes on the teacher at all times.
- 2. Repeat what the teacher says in your head.
- 3. Write down the important points your teacher says/draws.
- 4. Make yourself ask questions if there is anything the teacher says you don't understand.

After class:

- 1. Spend 15 minutes at a time, read through your notes each night and memorize them.
- **Study Tip: Make flashcards for vocabulary, placing terms on one side and definitions on the opposite side.
- 2. If needed, go see your biology teacher (or a different one) before or after school for help.

How can I study for the tests?

- 1. Study in 15 minute chunks every day!
- 2. Complete your study guide CORRECTLY! Use your book, not the internet!
